

DAY ONE SERVICES

Day One is the only organization in New York City solely devoted to the issue of dating violence. Working alongside youth, Day One educates, organizes and advocates on behalf of young people 24 years of age and under who are at risk of or experiencing intimate partner violence.

Day One assists young survivors of intimate partner violence in the five boroughs of New York City by providing the following services:

Community Education

- ✓ Interactive workshops for young people in middle and high school and college that address the warning signs of abuse, dynamics of power and control, different types of abuse and helping a friend
- ✓ Trainings for students to become peer educators or peer leaders in their schools
- ✓ Professional trainings for adults who work with youth addressing the fundamentals of dating violence, sexual assault and stalking; Title IX; domestic sex trafficking/commercial sexual exploitation of youth; and resources for young survivors
- ✓ **New Trainings for children, Kindergarten 6th grade and adult influencers

Direct Services

- ✓ Legal advice, information and full representation for youth seeking orders of protection, custody/visitation, child support and/or domestic violence-based immigration help
- ✓ Individual and group counseling and case management services
- ✓ Advocacy and support navigating the criminal court system with the goal of obtaining an order of protection
- ✓ Advocacy in an educational setting, such as assistance in obtaining a school safety transfer

Technical Assistance

✓ Technical assistance for schools that want to create or edit policies and procedures related to dating violence

Youth Voices Network

✓ Advocacy group for young survivors of dating violence who work on outreach and awareness projects
